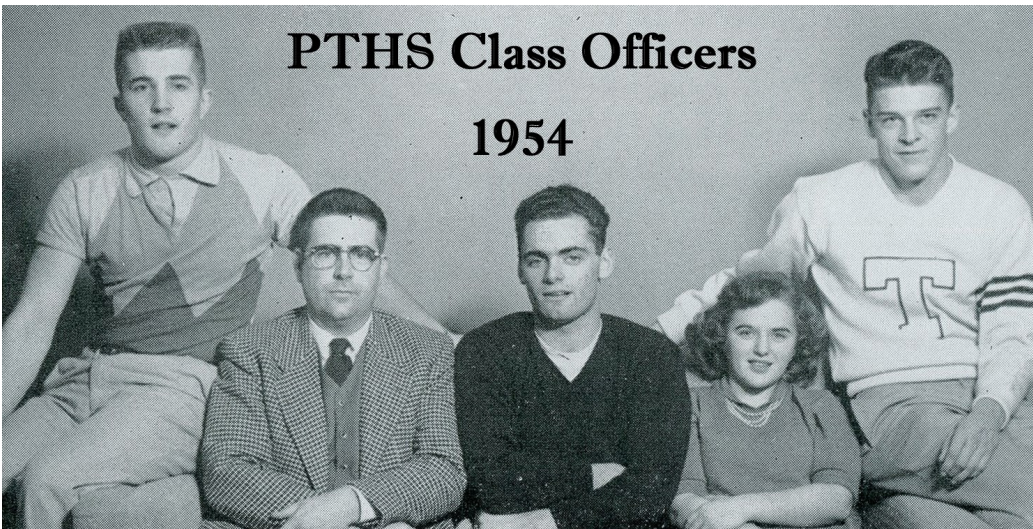
Formerly, only second-year students were admitted to the club, but this year rules were changed so first-year students could enter if they passed certain national skill tests.

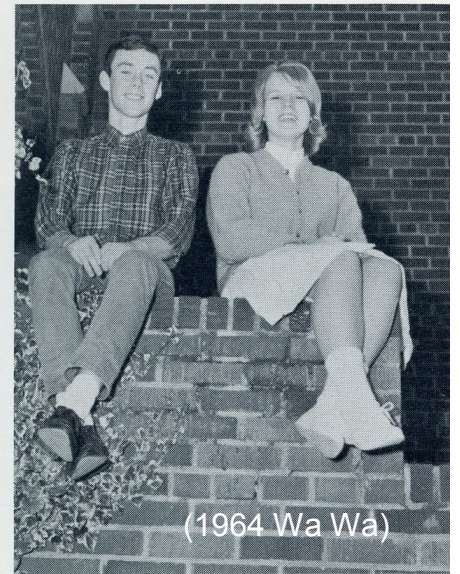

Girls in Sports

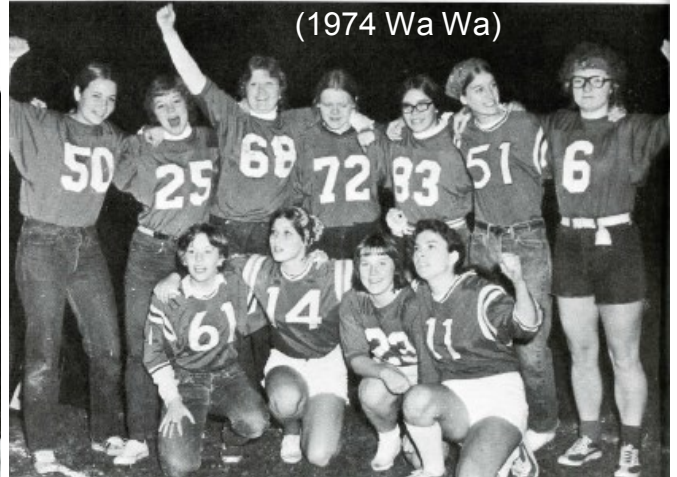

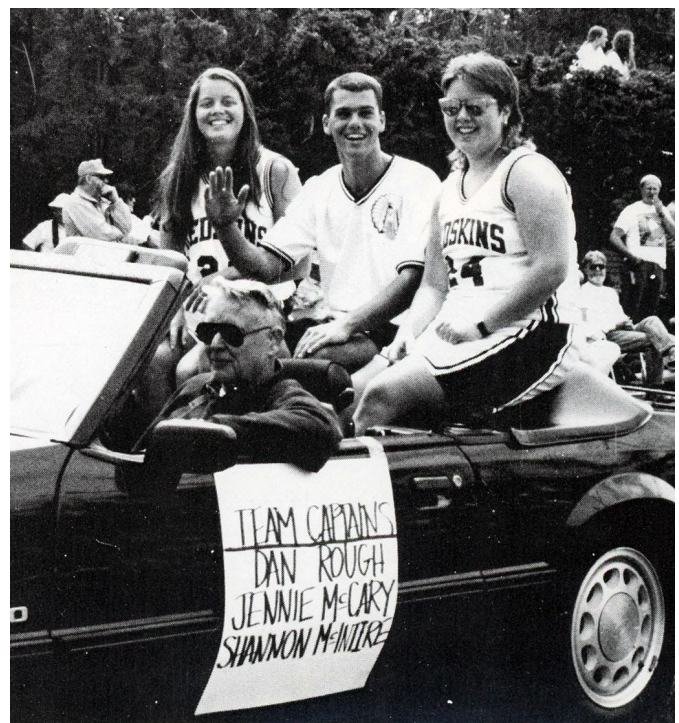
