Trammell found a good location near the gym for the Japanese Maple. I am thankful he cared enough to save the trees!

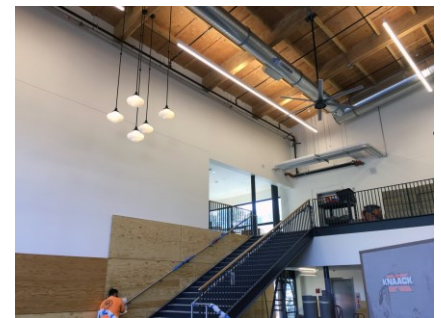


Everything Old is New Again!

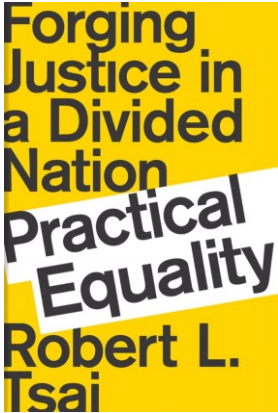

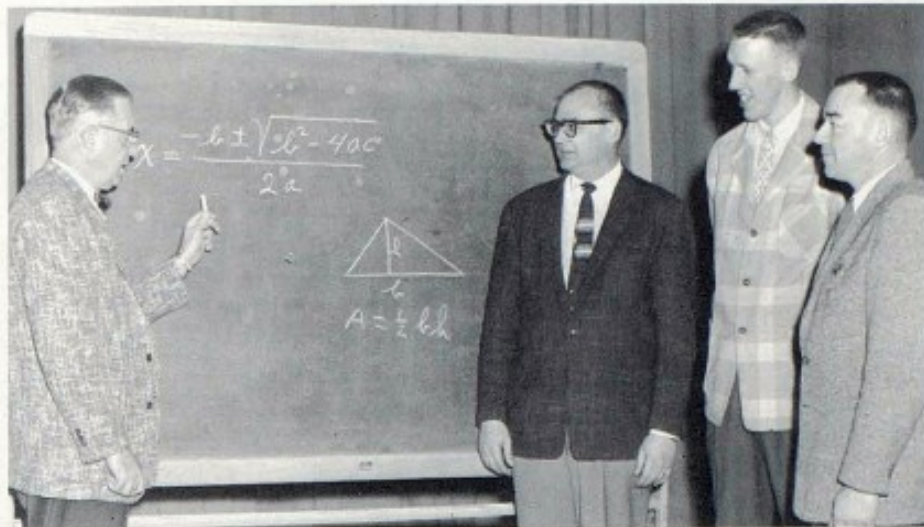
- The Future

Mr. Ralph Bohannon, besides being head basketball coach and assistant football coach, teaches general and practical mathematics and algebra. He also advises the Freshman Class.

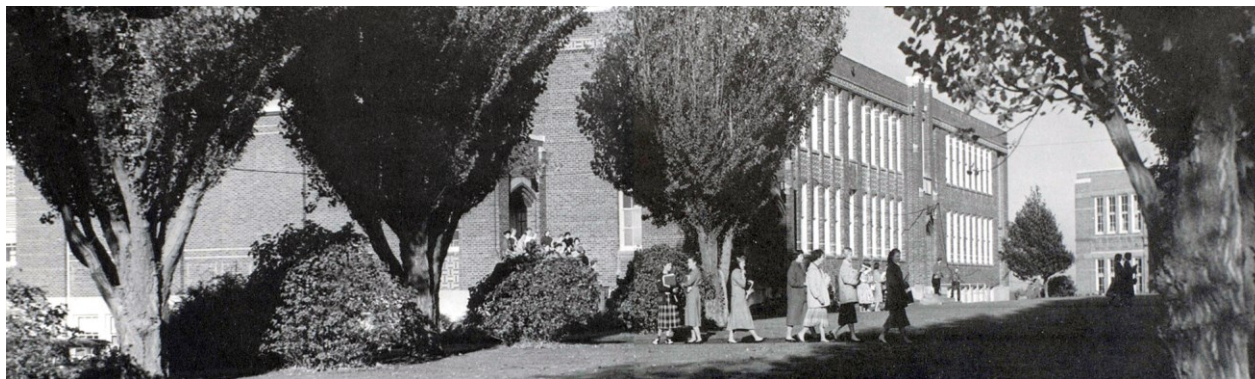
Every boy's interest is carried out in Mr. Donald Barrett's auto shop classes. Not only does he teach auto shop, but also a class of general mathematics.

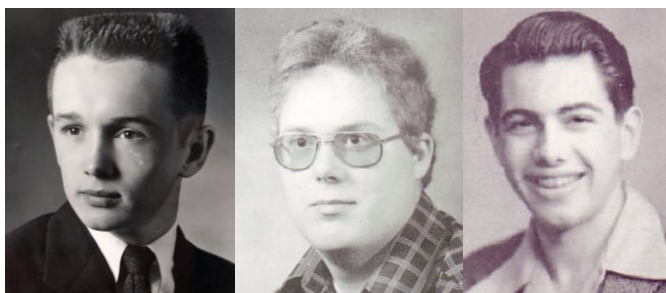
